SUBJECT: Army National Guard, Title 10, Active Guard Reserve, New Hire Announcements for Liaison Officer and Logistics Operations Officer, Army Materiel Command Reserve Component Mission Support Office, Redstone Arsenal, Alabama

#### 1. References:

a. AR 135-18 (The Active Guard Reserve Program)

b. NGB, ARNG-HRH memorandum (Title 10 (T10) Army National Guard (ARNG) Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Life Cycle Management (LCM) Strategy and Plan (PPOM 23-020)), 26 October 2023

2. The Army National Guard (ARNG) is seeking applications from highly qualified Captains to fill two critical positions at Redstone Arsenal, Alabama. The positions available are the ARNG Liaison Officer and the Logistics Operations Officer, both with an anticipated start date **1 September 2024**.

3. Waivers and exceptions. Request for waivers or exceptions to these requirements must be approved by ARNG-HRH. Requests for exceptions are processed by ARNG-HCM to ARNG-HRH.

#### 4. Eligibility.

a. Current T10 AGR, T10 ADOS, Title 32 (T32) AGR, and Traditional (M-Day) Officers in the rank of Captain. Captains must have at least two years' time in grade and meet all other prerequisites.

b. Applicants pending promotion must have Federal Recognition approved prior to accessing into the T10 AGR program.

c. New hires will have a minimum of eight years commissioned services.

d. New hires will have a minimum of four years ARNG service.

e. New Hires that cannot qualify for a 20-year Active Federal Service retirement require DARNG approval.

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f. New hires must have a minimum of 12 months of successful company command, except for those who Army doctrine has designated as “staff centric” and are not expected to hold company command experience. Therefore, those officers must have 12 months experience in one of the key developmental positions listed for their branch.

g. New hire officers will hold a minimum of a Bachelor’s degree.

h. New hires will have completed Captains Career Course.

5. Exemplary Conduct Certification Screening. All candidates who apply undergo screening before final selection is made.

6. Brief Duty Descriptions:

a. **ARNG Liaison Officer:** Serve as the Army National Guard Advisor to AMC and to the ARNG Assistant Deputy Commanding General (ADCG), AMC Mission Support Team. Responsible for managing and monitoring current year operations of training opportunities to RC units to gain skills in core competencies and build unit readiness.

b. **Logistics Operations Officer:** Serve as the Army National Guard advisor to AMC and to the ARNG Assistant Deputy Commanding General (ADCG), AMC Mission Support Team. Responsible for managing and monitoring current year operations of training opportunities to RC units to gain skills in core competencies and build unit readiness.

7. Prerequisites.

a. Applicants must meet AGR eligibility requirements IAW AR 135-18

b. Grade: O3

c. Branch Requirement: 90A

d. Civilian Education: Bachelor’s degree

e. Military Education: Commensurate with current rank held

f. Military Experience: Five or more years of specialized experience as a Logician

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g. Security Clearance: Secret
